In reply to your inquiry of June 20th, I regret to say that this office is prevented by existing regulations from giving authentic information as regards customs duties in Germany. I would suggest that you address your inquiry to the Canadian Trade Commissioner at Hamburg 1, Moenckebergstr.31, who will undoubtedly be in a position to procure the desired information for you, and who will also acquaint you with current German regulations concerning the payment for goods imported. All imports into Germany are subject to a foreign exchange permit, without which payment for goods bought cannot be effected.
