An incident has been brought to my attention by Ms. Susan Moloney, an AUCE member, working in the Faculty of Commerce and Business Administration.

On Wednesday, January 31, 1979, Ron Fraser, an instructor in your Faculty, shook his fist in her face, threw papers in her face and swore at her. This behaviour took place in the presence of six other AUCE members and yourself.

This type of treatment towards others cannot be condoned and I fail to understand your non-reaction to this matter.

Additionally, this letter wishes to state, on behalf of Ms. Moloney, that she is worried of repercussions from Mr. Fraser, as a result of her bringing the matter to your attention again, but is so offended by his behaviour she felt she had no other choice.
