In the matter of William Fulverwell a Bankrupt

I William Saunders Sebright Green of Victoria
Vancouver Island Solicitor to the Official
Assignee in the above Bankruptcy make oath
and say as follows

That I have been ~~by~~ informed and verily
believe that twenty three horses or mules or about
that number belonging to the estate of the above named
Bankrupt are now in the possession of John Banks
of Victoria aforesaid and that four horses belonging
^{to the same estate} are now in the possession of ~~John~~^{John}
Herbert Turner of the same place and that
one horse belonging to the same estate is now in
the possession of Alexander MacKinnon and that
one horse and buggy belonging to the same estate
are now in the possession of William Rowman
and that a number of horses and mules belonging
to the ^{same} estate are now in the possession, disposition
and order of John Parker of the same place and that
certain horses and mules belonging to the same estate
are now in the possession, disposition, and order of John
Henry Pitts of the same place and that one horse
belonging to the same estate is now in the possession
of ~~John~~ Callingham of the same place

2 That I have seen a receipt for thirty four horses
and mules signed by Henry Fry a stake to ranch by
him amongst the papers of the said William
Fulverwell and that the said Henry Fry has at
present only accounted for the disposition of
twenty four of the said horses and mules
