We wish to thank you for your letter of November 26th. and note the procedure to be followed for returning German made machines to Germany.

We however had planned, in order to avoid conflict in Germany with our more recent models, to ship the two machines in question to Denmark or Belgium.

In both cases we would require a certificate of origin. We would, therefore, be obliged to you if you would advise us whether you could issue a German Certificate of Origin if we submit the original invoice from our Westhoven (Cologne) Factory, if necessary together with a sworn statement certifying that these machines have actually been wholly manufactured in Germany.
