In Bankruptcy

In the matter of William Fulmerwell
a Bankrupt,

I Robert Russell Manager of the
Branch of the Bank of British North
America, at Parkville in British
Columbia, make oath and say:

1 That prior and subsequent to the
twenty seventh day of April last past
I was Accountant in the above Bank
at Victoria

2 That on or about the above date
William Fulmerwell above mentioned
called at the Bank during the day
and asked me to let him have an
agreement or security dated the thirtieth
day of November One Thousand Eight
hundred & Sixty ^{four} ~~five~~ ^{R.B.} made by "Wm
Nelson & Co" in favour of him Fulmerwell,
and by said Fulmerwell deposited in
the Bank as collateral security for his
indebtedness to the Bank, in order as
he stated that he might collect the
amount due on such security for
the Bank and apply the same in
reduction

+ four R.B.

redemption of his said indebtedness. Upon this express promise that he would collect the amount for the Bank and apply it as stated, I gave him the document above referred and I say that I would not have done so had not such promise been made

3 That I recollect the above transaction distinctly.

4 That the Bank has not to my knowledge, nor have I ever received the money so secured by the said security, nor has the said security ever ^{been} returned to the Bank that I am aware of.
