Dear Sirs,

We have recently received a copy of the Report of Group Compensation covering the Collective Agreement signed between the University of British Columbia and A.U.C.E. Local #1, as submitted to your office by the University; dated August 3, 1976.

On July 26,1976 the University of British Columbia sent us a letter advising us that the Minister of Finance of the Provincial Government, Evan M. Wolfe had requested the submission of the A.I.B. Forms 2 to the Anti-Inflation Board.

As per our Collective Agreement we indicated our willingness to make a joint submission to your office pending the receipt of the University's figures regarding the actual costs of contractual benefits for the duration of our Collective Agreement, October 1, 1975 to September 30, 1976. We also wished to discuss with them the possibility of applying for exemption according to the provisions of the Legislation.

Discussions with the University of British Columbia regarding a joint submission proved unsatisfactory and it was decided that both parties would make separate submissions.

As I mentioned earlier we have only recently received the figures forwarded to you by the University of British Columbia and we are currently examining them. We will be sending for your perusal our own submission within the week.

I hope this will not cause extensive inconvenience to your investigation.
