Gardener	While rolling turf employee turned rolling machine which resulted in lower back pain.
Cook	Cut thumb with knife.
Chef	Employee slipped on spilled water spraining wrist.
Truck Driver	While unloading truck, bag broke open, and frozen goods hit driver's foot.
Project Workers	While using a saw employee cut his finger. While splitting cedar shakes employee accidentally smashed right hand between the mallet and a block of wood.
Clerical	Punctured hand with pencil. While walking down stairs slipped and injured left forearm. While moving a heavy box employee's glasses fell off shattering one lens - seeking replacement of broken lens. While lifting mail bag worker felt a sharp pain in the back. While on the way to attending a meeting, employee fell on ice hitting her elbow and head. While using an electric stapler a staple flew into employee's eye breaking a contact lens.
Carpenter	A particle of dust flew in right eye. Worker slid on stairs jarring the back. Worker claims that working around high noise level machinery in the carpentry shop is a contributing factor in his partial hearing loss. (Under Investigation)
Laborer	Worker twisted ankle while walking down stairs. While lifting cabinet onto truck employee lost balance, fell backwards injuring leg.
Maintenance Eng.	Bruised ribs by turning too quickly.
Teacher	Slipped and fell down stairs injuring ankle.
Residence Attendant	While doing mail, a nerve became pinched in shoulder.
Biochemist	Plasm pipette broke and cut worker's hand.
Electrician	While cutting steel conduit with hacksaw the conduit shifted and employee cut left hand.
Bookstore Asst.	Slipped and fell which resulted in a fractured wrist.
Kiosk Attendant	While leaning out of window to collect money, the window dropped on attendant's hand.
Technician	While moving furniture employee experienced lower back pain. Experienced cut to thumb on a glass container. While cleaning knife hand slipped cutting index finger.
Designer	Cut thumb while unpacking crate.
Service Worker	Employee tripped while walking and pulled leg muscles. While cleaning blackboard, employee experienced pain to the wrist. (3 Claims)While lifting garbage employee felt pain in lower back area. While lifting garbage employee experienced pain in the forearm. Germicidal fumes irritated eyes of employee while cleaning. Irritation to employee's eye caused by flying broken glass. While mopping floor employee twisted and felt pain in lower back. Employee hurt right wrist while vacuuming.
