Dear Mr. Clark:

During last year's negotiations for A.U.C.E. Local No. 1's first contract with the University, our Contract Committee was unsuccessful in obtaining space on campus for our union office facilities. The reason given at that time by the University was simply that no space was available. This year we would like information about available space, indicating the locations, size, and any financial obligations.

If space were available and if our membership would agree to moving our facilities/office onto the campus at a suitable location, we would like to see the following things provided:

- i) space at least equivalent to our present arrangement; i.e., at least 800 sq. ft.
- ii) washroom facilities

iii) at least two rooms, one for equipment and supplies, the other for our Union Organizer/s and for meetings.

We would appreciate it if you would answer the points raised in this letter as soon as possible.
