



RE UNITED KINGDOM
TRADE AGREEMENT 1937.

By Order in Council (P.C. 1656) passed on the 15th July, 1937, under the authority of Section 3 of the United Kingdom Trade Agreement Act, 1937 (I Geo. VI, c.17), to maintain the intended margin of preference, it is ordered that, effective on and after the 26th day of February, 1937, importations of lace, nettings and bobinet produced in the United Kingdom and qualified for entry under the British Preferential Tariff, dutiable under tariff item 529, shall be entitled to a discount of 20% from the Preferential Tariff rate imposed under this item.
