The last three shifts are shortened since they are felt to be the least desirable. The last and first shift overlap by 45 minutes to accommodate the heavy traffic expected during the early morning. Shift captains will be assigned and they will be responsible for making the initial contact with individuals to inform them of their shift time and gate. It may be possible if there are enough people within your picket group to arrange some form of rotation, i.e., the odd night off. When these forms are correlated various people will be asked to fill other positions, such as sub-coordinator and coordinators.
