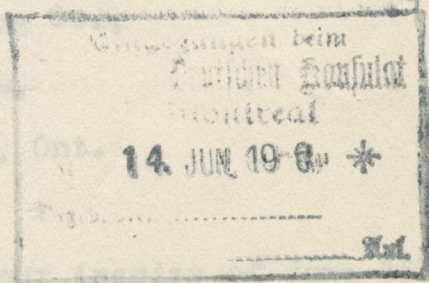

customs duty would not have to be included in your
quotation and might therefore be left out of consider-
ation when quoting, as it would in any case have to be
paid by the importer after unloading the goods.
