
At the recent 6th Annual AUCE Provincial Convention held just this past week-end, the Convention voted unanimously in favour of supporting the strike at the Muckamuck and as well to donate \$500 to the Muckamuck Workers' Strike Fund.

The Convention heard from Melody Rudd, AUCE #2 member, of how the owners of the Muckamuck Restaurant had been granted an injunction against picketing for two weeks; we also heard of the decertification application filed by certain employees scabbing at the Restaurant. It was the feeling of the Convention that the picketing injunction and the fact that the Labour Relations Board would even entertain the application for decertification calls for our solid support for the striking workers. Convention delegates are fully aware that this kind of intervention is indicative of the kind of arbitrary government involvement we may have to face in the future. Throughout the discussion member after member reminded the Convention that the SORWUC struggle is our struggle also.
