As Fairleigh Wettig informed you, in her letter of May 29, 1985, it has become necessary for us to change our name. Unfortunately, the name we chose — the University Employees Union — was objected to by Cupe 116. Their official name is the University of British Columbia Employees Union, and they felt that the similarity of the names would lead to confusion. Consequently, we have decided to call ourselves the Canadian University Employees. Our application to the Labour Relations Board has been appropriately amended, and we hope that the change will be made official by them in the near future.
