Dear Mr. Clark:

As per Article 5.02 New Employees - "As a condition of employment, new employees shall become Union members within thirty (30) calendar days of their date of hire."

This condition of employment is now being dealt with when new employees sign their dues authorisation form. Prior to the new forms the Union handled this aspect of the collective agreement.

[REDACTED] has been employed within the Computing Centre since November 14, 1979. He has refused to become a union member.

[REDACTED] has been employed at the Centre for Continuing Education since September 15, 1979. She has refused to become a union member.

Please bring this condition of employment to the attention of these University employees. The Union's position is that failure to join the union is cause for severance of employment.
