In Bankruptcy

In the matter of William
Culverwell a Bankrupt

I John Gustavus Norris of
the City of Victoria Gentleman make
oath and say as follows to wit
1 That I have been informed and
truly believe that divers quantities of
personal property of and belonging to
the estate of the above named Bankrupt
has been clandestinely conveyed from
the City of Victoria by Mrs Culverwell
to the residence of one James Curtis
who resides at Craigie Farm Victoria District
2 That the aforesaid Mrs Culverwell
is the wife of the said William Culverwell
3 That I truly believe that the
goods so removed as aforesaid, were
carried away with the intent and
design to defraud the creditors of
the above named Bankrupt.
