In reply to your letter of November 21st, I beg to say that, according to official regulations, consular authorities are not permitted to give information in customs matters. I would suggest that you address your detailed inquiry to the Canadian Trade Commissioner in Hamburg (Mr. L.D. Wilgress, Hamburg, Gutrufhaus, Neuer Wall 10), who would be in a position to obtain authentic information from the German Customs Authorities.

I have read with great interest of your plans to tour by water in Germany, and I would suggest that you communicate with the German Railroads Information Office, 665 Fifth Avenue, New York, who will undoubtedly be glad to supply you with the desired data.
