Dear Jane:

In response to your letter of March 6, 1981 in which you state that the Ministry of Human Resources would like to place a handicapped person in the Crane Library for no more than 20 hours per month and that this person would not be doing bargaining unit work, the Union has checked into the matter and responds as follows:

- the work to be done by the handicapped person needs to be done
- quite possibly it would be done by a bargaining unit person if funds permitted
- Crane Library will not be paying for this work to be done and it would not be done if Human Resources were not funding the work
- the person in question will be working approximately 20 hours per month of whatever amount they are permitted to by the Human Resources Ministry
- they would not be an employee of the University

We therefore see no problem, at this time, with the above person performing duties in the Crane Library but would of course keep an eye on this situation for the future.
