**MEMORANDUM**

DEPARTMENT OF NATIONAL REVENUE, CANADA  
 (CUSTOMS DIVISION)

DECEMBER 30, 1938.

*Collectors of Customs and Excise:*

**COPYRIGHT ACT, 1921, SECTIONS 27 AND 28**

Notice in writing has been given to the Department by the owners of copy-  
 right under provisions of Section 27 of the Copyright Act, 1921, that copyright  
 now subsists under the said Act in the original works hereunder mentioned, and  
 that they desire that copies of the said works printed or reprinted out of Canada  
 shall not be imported into Canada, and such copies are, accordingly, prohibited  
 importation as if included in Schedule C of the Customs Tariff, 1907, except how-  
 ever, as provided in subsection 3 of Section 28 of the said Act.


Note the exemptions from prohibition of importation provided in subsection
