## Fight Repression! Defend Our Rights!

As the trial for the SFU 18 opens on \_\_\_\_\_, the rights of B.C. workers are coming more and more under attack.

Last week, \_\_\_\_\_, a striker from Adams Laboratories in Surrey, was sent to jail for 6 months for defending the picket lines. An injunction forbidding verbal harassment sentenced 2 others to jail for 10 days and the union faces a fine of \$10,000. Capitalist justice has found Adams Lab strikers guilty of wanting a decent contract:

As for the SFU 18, their 'crime' is one of supporting a strike where workers were demanding a measly 9% wage increase over 2 years: 17 supporters of the SFU strike now face a maximum sentence of up to 2 years.

The charges and injunctions against Adams workers, Endako miners and the SFU 18 are the bleak record of the Socred government. As workers everywhere wage hard battles to defend their interests, the capitalists don't hesitate to use their governments, laws and police to try and break our struggles.

## Uniting Current Struggles - Key!

In response to these attacks, rank and file workers have shown determination in fighting back. In spite of police harassment and physical assaults on strikers by company goons, 12 Adams Lab strikers continue to maintain a 24 hour picket line:CUPW workers showed their determination by defying back to work legislation last fall.

As a communist organization, we actively support these struggles. But it's important that these struggles not remain isolated. Instead, rank and file strikers should join together and link their struggles. It is important for the SFU 18 to join with strikers from Adams Lab, CUPN and the farmworkers, whose basic rights are being denied by the Socred government. Together they could co-organize different actions like a press conference or demonstration outside Socred government offices. It's only through actions like these that we will be able to unite the working class and force the government to stop their attacks.
