
Copies of the third Annual Report of the Labour Relations Board of B.C. are now available from the Board's Vancouver office, at a charge of \$4.00 per copy.

The report is a document which deals with the main activities of the Board in the past year. It shows the work-load procedure and pattern of decisions of the Board in the various areas of its responsibility.

In the latter area, this Report singles out for expanded review three aspects of the Board's work -- representation votes, Section 36 and Section 108. Moreover, there is a brief discussion of the five newly enacted Statutes which affected the responsibilities of the Board: the Railway and Ferries Bargaining Assistance Act, the British Columbia Ferry Corporation Act, the Hospital Services Collective Agreement Act, the Public Construction Fair Wages Act, and the Labour Code of British Columbia Amendment Act, 1976. As well, we recall some of the events which highlighted labour-management relations in B.C. in 1976, and which surfaced in disputes before the Labour Relations Board.
