with reference to our conversation regarding raw Persian Lamb skins shipped to Messrs. Maranda & Labrecque, of Quebec, I beg to say that raw skins of all kinds are free from any import duty and from sales tax on importation into Germany. No sales tax is levied on such goods if exported. If sold for home consumption, a sales tax of ½ of 1% is levied.
