TARIFF CHANGE BY ORDER IN COUNCIL

By Order in Council (P.C. 1804), dated the 26th July, 1938, passed under the authority of Section 284, paragraphs (k) and (m) of the Customs Act, it is ordered that:

The undermentioned product when imported for the purpose specified be accorded for the period named the tariff treatment hereunder indicated:-

Trucks of welded design with tubular frame, cast steel cross members, rubber mountings and rubber inserted wheels, of a class or kind not made in Canada, for use in the construction of street railway cars, not to include electric motors or magnetic track brakes; complete parts of the foregoing:

From August 1, 1938, to September 30, 1938:

<u>British Preferential Tariff</u>	<u>Intermediate Tariff</u>	<u>General Tariff</u>
Free	Free	35 p.c.

(to be designated as Tariff item 828).
