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1. Minutes of the Meeting of Wednesday, March 28, 1984.

## 2. Business Arising from the Minutes

### a) Asbestos Removal

A concern about a strange smell was quickly resolved by the contractor to the satisfaction of Physical Plant and the complainant. Mr. Byrne of the Workers Compensation Board attended. There was no danger to health.

## b) Lighting

#### c) Carpet

Ms. Galbraith-Hamilton reported that Physical Plant had inspected the carpets

in the Faculty of Dentistry office area. No repairs have been made as yet to those carpets or carpets in general traffic areas.

### d) Air in Sealed Buildings

### e) Fire Safety Procedures

- ii. The fire bell on the First Floor has not been tested as yet. Mr. Gobert expects that this will be done before the next meeting.

#### 3. New Business

G. Poole of KNOW reported that the edges of the stairs are breaking away on several staps in the main stairway opposite the elevator. The broken edges are between the third floor and the basement. Concern was expressed that someone might fall. Mr. Nerland will be asked to have Physical Plant inspect the stairs and make appropriate repairs.
