Please be informed that I have received various letters from my customers informing me about the new set prices for "Crescent" Pattern Wrenches and "Stillson" Pattern Wrenches made in Germany.

Below please receive our prices as they are set by my principals, and I beg to mention that with the exception of 24" and 36" sizes, of the #2578 Stillson Pattern Wrenches, polished, all other prices are much lower than the new set values issued by the Canadian Government.
