The University of British Columbia and The Association of University College Employees, Local 1, have been in negotiations since August 13, 1976. Although the Union has presented each of its proposed articles two or three times on different occasions, only nine out of ninety-two proposed changes have thus far been agreed to. All of the more complex and controversial issues remain unresolved.

Based on the progress of negotiations to this date, the Union ~~felt~~^{feels} that a third party ~~was~~^{is} a necessity to conclude negotiations in a progressive manner. Therefore we have, this morning, requested through the Minister of Labour the services of a Mediation Officer.
