Dear Donella:

Re: Severance Notice - February 8, 1982

We received a copy of your severance notice today and I note that it has, as date of severance, February 5, 1982. Your appointment notice states that your termination date should be April 29, 1982.

I would like to draw your attention to Article 34.07 of the Collective Agreement which states, in part...."(a) All employees will receive one (1) month's written notice or one (1) month's pay in lieu of notice, except temporary employees who will receive two (2) weeks notice or two (2) weeks pay in lieu of notice. In any case the Union shall be notified in writing at the same time as the employee's concerned."

The Union has **not** received notice of layoff. If you did not receive two weeks notice of layoff, you are entitled to two weeks pay. The only time notice can be waived is if you work until the termination date on the appointment notice is reached.
