ITEMS 232 AND 232C


The last sentence in paragraph 3 of Memorandum Series D No. 49 TMR-4, reading as follows,-

"In cases where the containers are not properly marked, the necessary markings shall be done by an inspector or other proper officer of the Department of Agriculture at Ports where such officers are located; and at Ports where no such officers of the Department of Agriculture are located, it shall be done by a proper Customs officer".

is cancelled, and the following is substituted therefor,-

In cases where the containers are not properly marked, the necessary markings shall be done by the importer, under direction and supervision,-

- (a) of an officer of the Department of Agriculture at Ports where such officers are located;
- (b) of a Customs officer at Ports where no officers of the Department of Agriculture are located.
