In cases where the containers are not properly marked, the necessary markings shall be done by the importer, under direction and supervision, -

- (a) of an officer of the Department of Agriculture at Ports where such officers are located;
- (b) of a Customs officer at Ports where no officers of the Department of Agriculture are located.
