Dear Sirs,

Your letter of May 10th, addressed to the German Consulate at Toronto, has been referred to this office. I would advise you to attach to the bills of lading the original invoice for the gloves which you wish to return to Germany, and to furnish the consignee with a declaration on your part that the goods described are returned goods and that they are returned for such and such a purpose. It would then be up to the German consignee to take the matter up with the German customs authorities. No other special formalities are, to my knowledge, to be observed. It would be sufficient if the signature which you have put under your statement is confirmed as being your signature by the German Consulate, Toronto.
