⑦ 9:45 a.m. Svend Robinson, Board of Governors member picked up contract committee briefs for Bob members. Will contact us when he has delivered them.

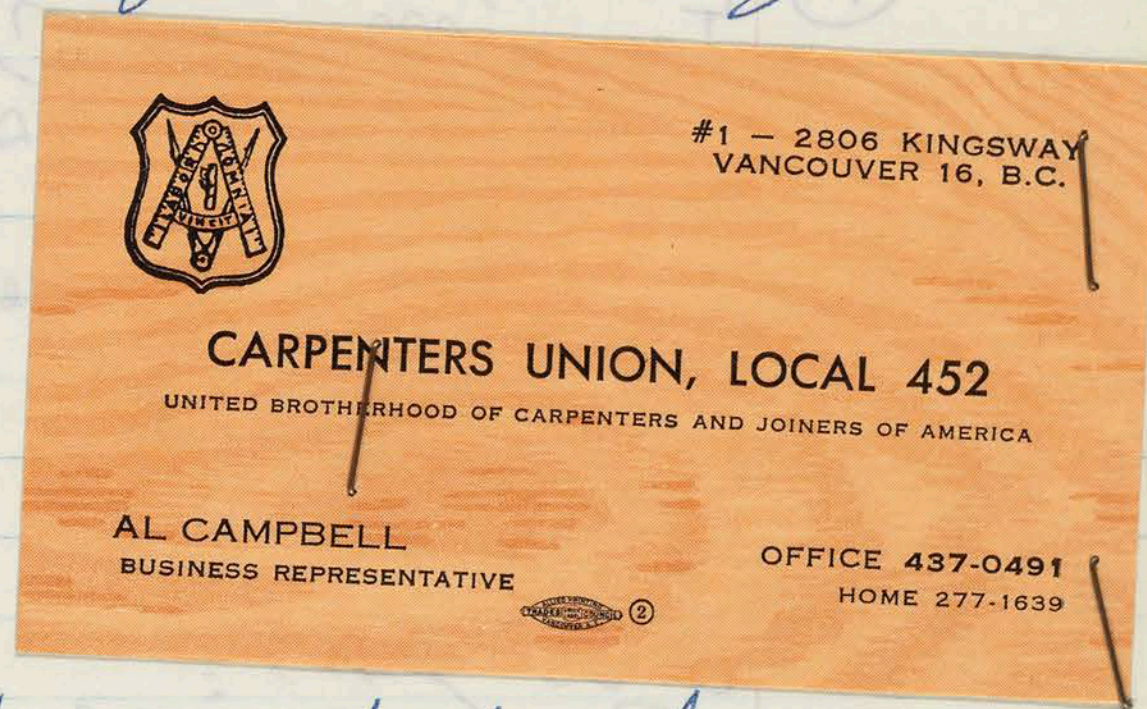
⑧ Carpenters' Union, local 452 representative, Al Campbell, left ~~and~~ number for us to call him if workers are found working on pool construction site.
