To Collectors of Customs and Excise,
and others concerned:

TARIFF CHANGE BY ORDER IN COUNCIL

By Order in Council (P.C. 2359), dated the 21st September, 1938, passed under the authority of Section 284, paragraphs (k) and (m) of the Customs Act, it is ordered that:

The undermentioned product when imported for the purpose specified be accorded for the period named the tariff treatment hereunder indicated:-

Trucks of welded design with tubular frame, cast steel cross members, rubber mountings and rubber inserted wheels, of a class or kind not made in Canada, for use in the construction, maintenance and repair of street railway cars, not to include electric motors or magnetic track brakes; complete parts of the foregoing:

From October 1, 1938 to November 30, 1938:

British Preferential Tariff.....	Free
Intermediate Tariff.....	Free
General Tariff.....	35 p.c.

(to be designated as Tariff item 828).
