1. PROS & CONS OF PREVIOUS PICKETING SCHEDULE

It was suggested that the main-coordinators only be responsible for this duty i.e. that an executive member only serve on the executive and not be required to be a main coordinator.

CARRIED.

It was felt that one of the main criticisms of the previous picketing schedule was the overlapping shifts. i.e. people did not feel obligated to arrive on picket duty on time as there were people from the previous shift covering.

Roberta Crosby re-affirmed the need for a 24 hour shift period. In light of this, it was suggested by Roberta that the greatest need was to fill the night shifts first.

Pat Gibson felt the need for the picketers to have a break in picket duty. Furthermore, that people not willing to picket be given other assigned duties i.e. Office Communications. In general, it was felt that these suggestions would be persued further at the Full Strike Committee Meeting on Tuesday, December 16, 1975.
