I beg to say that according to the terms of the Provisional Trade Agreement and Payments Agreement between
Canada and Germany, the payment for goods imported from
Germany has to be effected in straight foreign exchange.

The agreement provided for a period of six months during
which barter transactions were still permissible. This
period has elapsed some time past.
