In reply to your inquiry of July 27th,
I beg to say that according to the terms of the Pro-
visional Trade Agreement and Payments Agreement between
Canada and Germany, the payment for goods imported from
Germany has to be effected in straight foreign exchange.
The agreement provided for a period of six months during
which barter transactions were still permissible. This
period has elapsed some time past.
