

We are seeking your support for and participation in the 1984 B.C. Conference on Human Rights. You have already received a letter from Operation Solidarity endorsing the conference. It has also been endorsed by the B.C. Federation of Labour and numerous other groups.

Bill Bennett and the provincial Socreds claim that last summer's legislation, particularly human rights legislation and labour code revisions, is necessary to attract international investment. We naturally oppose this policy. The conference will examine the connections between international economic forces and the deterioration of human rights protection in the province.
