BE it remembered, that on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of October in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and Twenty nine in the City of Victoria of the Province of British Columbia in the District or County of ~~Province of British Columbia~~ personally came before me, one of Her Majesty's Justices of the Peace in and for the said District or County of ~~Province~~ and acknowledged himself to owe to our Sovereign Lady the Queen, Her heirs and successors, the sum of Two Hundred dollars of good and lawful current money of Canada, to be made and levied of his goods and chattels, lands and tenements, to the use of Our said Sovereign Lady the Queen. Her heirs and successors, if the said Ah Yung shall fail in the condition endorsed.

THE condition of the within written recognizance is such that whereas one Lee Fook, Superintendent & Justice of the Peace within mentioned, for that the said Lee Fook, did on the afternoon of the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of October 1879, at Hornum and Street in the said City of Victoria unlawfully assault the said Ah Yung by striking him on the face and on the head with a piece of iron, contrary to the Statute

if therefore, he the said Ah Yung shall appear at the next Court of Assises to be holden in and for the District or County of said City of Victoria and there give such evidence as he knoweth upon a Bill of Indictment to be then and there preferred against the said Lee Fook for the offence aforesaid, as well to the Jurors who shall there enquire of the said offence, as also to the Jurors who shall pass upon the trial of the said Lee Fook if the said Bill shall be found a True Bill, then the said Recognizance to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
