

Minutes of Meeting of Creditors of John Joseph
McCordy a Bankrupt held at the Office of William
Parsons Hayward Esquire Wharf Street Victoria
on Saturday the Eighth day of August
A.D. 1866.

Mr. Hayward was proposed as Chairman of the

meeting and was thereupon duly elected by the meeting.

Mr. Hayward in the Chair.

Mr. McCordy stated to the meeting that he proposed
to pay $\$25$ on the Dollar on all his debts, as composition in
full thereof payable as follows. one half to be payable in twelve
months from this date, - the other half to be payable in two years
from this date.

Mr. Harrison proposed as follows. viz. That the
creditors accept of a composition of fifty cents on the Dollar on their
debts to be payable by (Notes) approved endorsed notes at ninety
days date on condition that the Bankrupt pay all costs incurred
by the Creditors to date.

The proposition of Mr. McCordy having been put to the
meeting was declared lost, - no party voting first.

The proposition of Mr. Harman was then put to the meeting and carried unanimously.

It was proposed by Mr. Kelly and unanimously agreed to that this meeting adjourn till Tuesday evening next at 7 o'clock to give ^{John Joseph Murphy} the ~~Banrupt~~ an opportunity to state his acceptance or rejection of the proposition made by Mr. Harman.
