- picked up mail and labels for up coming referendum

- took letter of agreement to Marcel to be endorsed and discussed grievance with him.

- Dan called asked me to look for the minutes from the [redacted] arbitration - good luck.

- Went through backlog of old files in an attempt to rid them of redundancy and find them a home.

Mon. June 28/76

- Phoned Shirley Chan to find out when she needed wk party for referendum.

- Received over the phone from Communications Ctte. list of work party volunteers. Phoned all people on the list to get them to help today.

- Called Margie to find out time and place of Contract mtg.

- Called everyone on the executive to let them know about Special Exec. Mtg. Wed. June 30/76

- Typed and ran off 1400 copies of letter on Mario Mustoz to go in newsletter.

- Met new member from Museum for lunch to answer questions on rights and membership.

- Organized some things for work party.

- Phoned L.R.B. to get information on illegal promotion - does someone who has been promoted and then has to go back to original position - is salary red circled at higher pay grade - answer No unless in collective agreement.
