Dear Sir:

We have imported about nine carloads of steel from Germany between the period of Nov. 24/34 and May 8/36.

Unfortunately the import entries were made unaware of the fact of a tax that was in force in Germany and evidently our price on the invoices did not include this tax and on the most recent shipment that we imported the government has assessed us a dump.

We would therefore request of you to tell us the date on which this special tax went into effect in Germany and if the amount were at any time different from 2 per cent. With this information, we can intelligently follow the customs on any dump that they impose on us in regards to this German tax.




