

WHY STUDENTS SUPPORT CAMPUS WORKERS

■ Over 3000 workers are poised to strike at UBC for wages above the poverty line and pay equity for women. At present, the university is offering a 3 year contract with less than 4% increase in the first year, and 0 in the next two years. This is union busting!

■ This offer is part of the university administration's strategy to make workers and students pay for the education crisis. Tuition at UBC has risen by 1/3 in the last 3 years and will go up again next year. There is money for Kaon research and Strangway's \$200,000 salary, but none for teaching or library books for students.

YOUR RIGHTS: Every student has the right to NOT cross the picket lines with NO PENALTY. Provided you contact your faculty. Read the university calendar for detailed information on your right of appeal if penalties are threatened.
