#### **Administrative History**

The records in this fonds are related to the United Nations Conference on Human Settlements (Habitat) and the UN Commission on Human Settlements.

The United Nations Conference on Human Settlements was first held May 31-June 11, 1976 in Vancouver. Known as Habitat (later Habitat I), the conference was created to address human settlements issues including policies and strategies, settlement planning; shelter, infrastructure and social services, land use, public participation, and institutions and management. Habitat I was made up of the official UN conference as well as concurrent unofficial events known as the Habitat Forum. The events included an extensive audio-visual programme, and Vision Habitat was established to administer and maintain the audio-visual materials following the conference.

Now known as the UN Human Settlements Program (UN-Habitat), it continues the work started in the 1970s, including Habitat II (Istanbul, Turkey in 1996) and Habitat III (Quito, Ecuador in 2016), as well as numerous World Urban Forums—the third Forum bringing Habitat back to Vancouver in 2006.

The Association in Canada Serving Organizations for Human Settlements (ACSOH) was responsible for the unofficial, NGO and community engagement and the Habitat Forum.

The Centre for Human Settlements, part of the School of Community and Regional Planning (SCARP) at the University of British Columbia, was opened as a result of Habitat, to encourage settlement research and serve as a repository for audio-visual materials of Habitat. Dr. H. Peter Oberlander founded and served as director of both SCARP and the Centre for Human Settlements, and was involved in Habitat I. Oberlander was part of the Canadian delegations to the UN Commission on Human Settlements, he advocated to bring the 2006 World Urban Forum 3 to Vancouver, and he served as special assistant to the Secretary-General for Habitat II.

#### Scope and content

The fonds contains records of the ACSOH, Habitat I and Vision Habitat, as well as Oberlander's records related to Habitat II, World Urban Forums 2 and 3, and other UN Habitat associated activities and research. Contents mainly consist of correspondence, reports, publications, governance and planning documentation and research.

#### **Custodial history**

The ACSOH donated materials to the Centre for Human Settlements, and Oberlander relayed the materials to Rare Books and Special Collections in October 1976. SCARP donated additional records in 2017. Reviewing this accrual, it appears to include Vision Habitat's records (headquartered at the Centre for Human Settlements) and Oberlander's records of involvement in UN Habitat.

#### Arrangement

PART 1 (Boxes 1-10) is the inventory of materials processed for the original ACSOH donation.

PART 2 (Boxes 11-28) finishes processing the 1976 donation and describes the 2017. The files were received in no explicit arrangement, but associations between files were identifiable through handwriting, folder types, and notes on the records. To respect this connectedness, the archivist divided this part into three series: 1. Habitat I (including Habitat Forum); 2. Vision Habitat; 3. Beyond Habitat I. Boxes 17-22 are the conclusion of the 1976 acquisition.

The archivist made efforts to remove duplicate reports, publications, and records within a file. However, duplicates may exist between Part 1 and Part 2, and between files or series.

#### Language

The majority of items are in English, and there are many French documents. The Habitat I series contains some materials produced in other languages as well.

#### **General note**

Many of the records were stored in clearly labeled folders, and those file titles have been retained. In instances of records stored in unlabeled folders or loosely placed in boxes, the archivist created titles to reflect the contents of the file; these titles are indicated by square brackets.

#### **Related Materials**

The audio-visual records of Habitat I are held by University Archives in the Centre for Human Settlements fonds. The H. Peter Oberlander fonds at University Archives also includes related materials.

Some materials in this fonds, as well as many other related materials, were digitized by the Habitat Conferences Digital Archive, a project of the School of Community and Regional Planning at UBC: https://habitat.scarp.ubc.ca/.

#### INTRODUCTION

When I first encountered the collection, there were abut twenty-four boxes of sorted material (already shelved) and four cardboard boxes of unsorted material. It appeared that the task at hand should proper to be quite straightforward - simply the incorporation of the unsorted information into the sorted, but after examining the sorted material I soon disconvered that a very rough sort had been done. In many cases the folders contained information that was totally unrelated to the designated subject heading. The collection had been given a division according to format-specifically corresdpondence and this was grouped within a series of either 1, 2, or 3. After considerable examination I was unable to detect the rationale for the existence for the series, so I decided to eliminate the superficial division and only group together the executive's correspondence (Box 12, 12A) and general enquiries correspondence (Box 7,8,9). Any additional correspondence was filed with material that related to it in subject matter.

The rearrangement and elimination of dup/ication within the sorted material proved to be far moretime consuming than might have been anticipated. It was not until after the third week that I was actually able to file the unsorted information. The total collection now consists of thirty-seven boxes.

Although the present inventory provides access to the Habitat Collection, it must in no way be considered to be a final inventory.

Due to the limited time factor a great deal could not be re-examined. For persons who will be working with the collection in the future certain aspects should be examined.

As two people had already worked on this, and the second had not comprehended the logic of the first, I felt I ought not to tamper with the structure established by Barbara but to follow her recommendations as far as time permitted.

My main efforts have been to arrange items chronologically within designated folders, to weed duplicates, remove paperclips, and occasionally to reassign items that very obviously should have been elsewhere.

Initially I worked on retaining a 5% sample of the reams of requests for inclusion on mailing lists.

If there is pressure with space later, I believe this collection could be cut down greatly without destroying the contents: much peripheral material e.g. advertising, general inquiries, papers of previous conferences that don't relate closely with Habitat. There is also the question that Barabara mentions, and I didn't investigate duplication between the Forum Discussion papers Box 1-5, Box 17, Box 21.

Within some boxes and folders there does not seem much logic in the contents, but to tamper with that would have been too enormous a task.

#### **Scope and content**

Two large boxes of records from the first accrual, which were not processed in the 1970s and therefore not included in the original inventory (Part 1 of this finding aid), were processed as part of this series and became boxes 17 to 22. These include UN reports and documents published before, during, and after the conference, as well as a large collection of official national reports, NGO reports, and publications from participating countries and organizations.

The materials in this series from the 2017 accrual—boxes 12 to 16—are related to HABITAT and Habitat Forum. It includes a number of official and unofficial publications about the conference, including newspapers, magazines, press releases, and books, mostly published prior to or during Habitat.

Additionally, the series contains proposals and planning documents and correspondence, records (such as directories) produced for use during Habitat, and reports and other records of numerous symposia and events held around Canada in anticipation of Habitat.

#### Arrangement

This series contains six boxes from the original donation. The UN's HABITAT I documentation (box 17) is arranged according to the order it was received, which appears to be based on document type (indicated on each item's official document registration number). The materials in boxes 18-22 had no arrangement. In order to aid access, the archivist arranged materials according to identified by country or organization and filed alphabetically. Items without a clearly decipherable origin or connection to the conference were placed in a misc. file at the end of box 22.

The rest of the files in this series, which were received as part of the 2017 accrual, were identified from the rest of the accrual by the focus on Habitat I, the dates of creation, and the frequent address to Robin Freid or handwritten notes of "RF" or "Robin Freid."

Multiple duplicates of the UN reports and country submissions were removed from this series.

This series contains the records of Vision Habitat, the organization responsible for preserving and disseminating the audio-visual material of Habitat I. It includes records of the organization and its deputy director, James Carney, who was located at the Centre for Human Settlements. The series covers the development of Vision Habitat: plans for the creation of the Centre, the transfer of materials to the centre, the screening and reviewing of content, and securing details of copyright distribution of the audio-visual contents. Records types include correspondence (letters and telexes), architectural drawings, catalogues, reports, publicity, invoices, and memos. In addition, the records convey daily activities such as requests for materials, financial reports, and personnel files.

#### Arrangement

The files in this series were identified from the rest of the accrual by the content of the files, the identical file folders, and the frequent addressing of records to James Carney.

#### **Scope and content**

This series includes textual records of Dr. Oberlander's involvement in and research on UN Habitat. It contains reports, publications, planning and governing documents, and conference materials related to UN Habitat as an organization, the legacy of Habitat I (such as local planning documents from the 1980s and 1990s), as well as specific events and activities including World Urban Forum 2, World Urban Forum 3, Habitat II, and Millennium Development Goals.

The majority of this series appears to have been accumulated by Oberlander and collaborators for the 2006 publication, *Towards Sustainable Urbanization: Canada/UN-HABITAT Initiatives 1976-2006*, for the World Urban Forum 3. In addition to drafts of the work and research about the history and impact of UN Habitat, the series includes files identifying Habitat-related materials at UBC and across Canada, such as catalogues, bibliographies, library and archival records, and correspondence with institutions regarding their holdings.

#### Arrangement

The records in this series were identified by the dates of creation and accumulation of the records, their similar file folders and handwriting, and the content's connection with Oberlander.

Duplicates of research materials, such as multiple copies of the UBC library catalogue records and archival inventory, were removed.
