I Bartholomew Derham of the City of
Victoria Vancouver Island Baker and Trader
make oath and say as follows that is to say.

- 1 That in or about the month of July One
Thousand eight hundred and sixty two I
caused to be deposited in the Store of Thomas
Hester Farrell at Kellogg in British Columbia
certain Goods and Merchandise to the Value of
Five hundred dollars and upwards and on the
deposit of such Goods I took and obtained or
was delivered by agent for me a Receipt for
such Goods and Merchandise
- 2 That the said Goods and Merchandise were
simply stored and deposited by me, and not
sold to the said Thomas Hester Farrell, but
he notwithstanding, as I am informed and
believe sold the same and applied the proceeds
to his own use
- 3 That I have examined the Schedule and
accounts filed by the Bankrupt in this
Case and my name does not appear as
a Creditor.
